

SOCIAL Name Badges

It is very important to be able to identify categories of volunteers and guests who attend the Social. Using different colored name badges or having identifications such as “caregiver” pre-printed on guest badges, is very helpful.

I. Volunteer Registration/Badges

When volunteers arrive, they sign in with the time they arrive and they are given name badges.

- If you are working with a university and have both faculty members and students volunteering, it is highly recommended that you differentiate the colors of the badges they receive.

For example, faculty members and other professional autism service providers might receive badges with **green borders**

Student volunteers might receive badges with **red borders**.

II. Guest Badges

When guests arrive and register, adults with autism receive a name badges with a different border color, for example, **blue**.

Caregivers are given name badges with another color, like **gold**.
